Cerințe pentru înscrierea lucrărilor în concurs:

- o lucrare per persoană, de dimensiuni max. 58cm X 38cm, sau pe pânză, de dimensiune mai mica de mărimea F8;
- tema la alegere;
- tehnici: acuarelă, ulei, pastel, colaj hârtie etc.

Nu sunt acceptate lucrările de artă care au suprafețe sensibile și ușor de rupt. De asemenea, nu sunt acceptate lucrările de artă care conțin produse comestibile perisabile sau care atrag insect, precum cerealele. Fiecare lucrare trebuie să fie realizată chiar de copil și nu trebuie să fi apărut deja în alte competiții. Lucrarea nu trebuie să fie înrămată, cele înrămate nu sunt acceptate! Picturile în ulei trebuie făcute doar pe pânză. Nu sunt acceptate lucrări modelate sau lucrări digitale. Lucrările de artă realizate în cooperare nu sunt acceptate!

Jurizarea va începe la sfârșitul lunii ianuarie 2017, iar câștigătorii vor fi selectați la sfârșitul lunii februarie 2017. Lista câștigătorilor va fi postată în luna martie 2017 pe site-ul concursului <http://www.earthplaza.jp/biennial/English/index.html>.

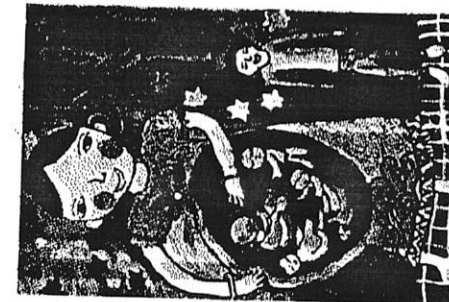

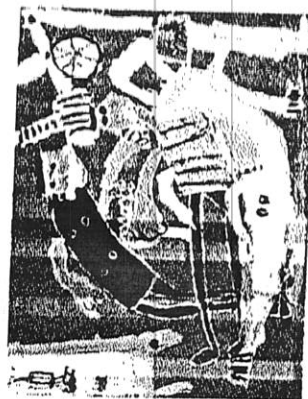

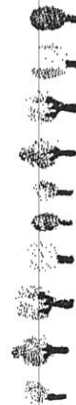

Kanagawa Biennial World Children's Art Exhibition Application Guidelines

The Kanagawa Biennial World Children's Art Exhibition has been held every two years since 1981. Held in Kanagawa Prefecture to the south of Tokyo, this event exhibits children's art from all over the world, and is intended to use the power of painting to foster the dreams and creativity of today's young children who will go on to become the leaders of tomorrow. The exhibition is also intended to further understanding of the world's diverse cultures and differences in global lifestyles.

The previous 18th Kanagawa Biennial World Children's Art Exhibition was held from July to August 2015, and saw over 26,000 individual entries from 95 countries and 2 regional nations. Looking to build on this success, the 19th exhibition is scheduled to be held from July to August 2017 and we look forward to another record intake of entries.

- ④ **Entries**
One entry per person. (Each entry shall be the entrant's own work and shall not have appeared in any previous competition.) Collaborative works or part of a series of works shall not be accepted.
- ⑤ **Other**
Do not frame the work. Oil painting entries should be painted on canvas only.
*Framed entries shall not be accepted.

⑥ **Materials**
Watercolor, Oil, Crayon, Pastels, Print, Paper collage, etc.
*Modeled entries with uneven and easy-to-break surfaces shall not be accepted. Entries containing food products that may rot or attract insects, etc., such as cereal, shall not be accepted.

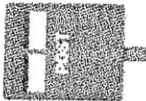
Unacceptable Works

- ③ **Size**
Quarto size (within 54 cm x 38 cm).
Canvas pieces should be less than F8 size.
*Entries exceeding these dimensions shall not be accepted, because of our frame size of exhibition.

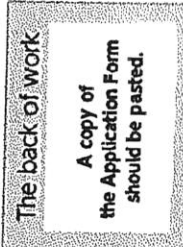
Receipt of Entries

The works by e-mail shall not be accepted. Only Group entry sheet by e-mail can be accepted. Please see the attached entry sheet for more information.



Judging Period and Notification of Awards

Judging will start at the end of January 2017, and the winners will be selected by the end of February 2017. A list of the winners will be posted on the Kanagawa Biennial's website in March 2017.

- ④ The invitations for recipients of the Grand Prize are not planned.
