Vă informăm, prin prezenta, cu privire la desfășurarea evenimentului concursului de desene "Marea Neagră, marea care ne unește", organizat de Secretariatul Permanent al Organizației de Cooperare la Marea Neagră (OCEMN) la inițiativa Ministerului Educației și Afacerilor Religioase din Grecia.

Formatul de concurs - A3, tehnica - la alegere.

Fiecare țară membră OCEMN va trimite organizatorilor lucrarea câștigătoare la nivel național până la data de 31.10.2019.

Prin urmare, la nivelul fiecărui județ va fi selecționată o lucrare care va participa la selecția națională.

Județele care vor să participe vor trimite lucrarea selecționată, până la data de 25.10.2019, pe adresa București, Str. General Berthelot nr. 28-30, Sector 1, 010168, cu mențiunea "pentru concursul Marea Neagră, marea care ne unește", împreună cu fotografia lucrării la rezoluția de 300 dpi, în format electronic, la adresa de e-mail braescua@yahoo.com.

Rezultatul selecției naționale va fi comunicat până la data de 01.12.2019.

Drawing Competition on the Black Sea

CONCEPT NOTE

The Ministry of Education and Religious Affairs, under the Hellenic Chairmanship-in-Office of the BSEC, has the pleasure to launch a drawing competition entitled "Black Sea; the sea that unites us".

The competition will take place in all member-states of the BSEC, starting in September and ending on the 31st of October 2019.

The BSEC Member States are invited to participate in the competition voluntarily and conduct it in compliance with their own legislation and relevant educational procedures.

Through their participation in the competition, young students will have the opportunity to:

- Learn about the origin of the name of the Black Sea and relative mythological/historical information on the provenance of its name, as well as the name of the sea in some of the languages of the BSEC member-states.
- Gather information on BSEC's Member States, the language/s spoken, the religion/s, local habits, and customs.
- Learn about the historical relations of the peoples living in the broader geographical area.
- Be informed on the natural richness of the Black Sea and its importance for the ecosystem, to better protect it from pollution, and the risks involved for the planet as a result of the climate change.
- Finally, students will receive information on the role of the International Organizations and their contribution to the relations between states, the progress and prosperity of their peoples.

The aim of the competition is to stimulate the interest of the BSEC Member States' young students in the wider Black Sea region and the important role that BSEC plays in fostering friendship and cooperation among them.

Through the collection of the above-mentioned information, students of the BSEC countries will be better prepared to approach the topic of the Competition and create a painting work depicting the importance of the Black Sea for the wider region, as perceived by each one of them.

The competition is addressed to secondary education students, aged 14-15.

The participation in the competition of both schools and students of the BSEC member-states is not compulsory.

Students who are interested in participating are expected to draw on the specific topic, on **A3 paper** (or other material) size, expressing themselves in their personal style and using painting materials of their choice.

Each BSEC Member State is invited to select **one (01) work**. The work selected by the competent educational authorities should be **photographed** and saved in a **digital file** at a **resolution of 300 dpi**.

The participating BSEC Member States are expected to send the photograph of the work to the Hellenic Ministry of Education by e-mail (BSEC_draw_compet@minedu.gov.gr), **in digital form**, before the deadline (**31 October 2019**).

The work of painting, in digital form, should be accompanied by **one A4 page** with the **name and the surname of the student**, the **name of the school he/she attends**, as well as the **name of the School Head**, **school telephone number and e-mail**, **postal address**, and **country**.

Deadline: 31st October 2019.

Both the original work and the digital file containing the photograph should be kept by the respective school authorities of each BSEC Member State until the announcement of the results.

In the Hellenic Ministry of Education (the Directorate for European and International Affairs), in Athens, an ad hoc non-remunerated Committee will be set up, to select **three (03) painting works** out of the total sent by e-mail to the Ministry within the deadline.

The Committee will be composed of administrators of the **General Directorate** for International, European Affairs, Education of the Greeks of the Diaspora and Intercultural Education, the **Directorate** for European and International Affairs, the **Unit** for International Relations and the **administrative employee** who is responsible for the Competition and represents the country to the BSEC, as well as **one representative from the Hellenic Ministry of Foreign Affairs** (Directorate B02) and **one representative from the Permanent International Secretariat (PERMIS) of the BSEC**. The works of all the participants, in their digital form, will be examined by the said Committee.

The selection of the winners by the Committee will take place no later than **10 November 2019** and the results will be announced to all the BSEC Member States that have taken part in the competition.

Selection criteria: Degree of the work's relevance to the subject of the competition, the aesthetic and artistic integrity of the work as well as the degree of originality (novelty/creativity) of the artistic approach of the subject.

Three (03) prizes will be awarded, as follows:

1st and 2nd prizes: One method for learning Greek (levels A1 and A2) for adolescents and adults (edited by the Center for the Greek Language, K.E.F.), accompanied by one Greek ↔ English Dictionary (edited by the Greek Institute for Language and Speech Processing, I.F.

3rd prize: One method for learning Greek (level A1) for adolescents and adults (edited by the Center for the Greek Language, K.E.T.), accompanied by one Greek <->English Dictionary (edited by the Greek Institute for Language and Speech Processing, I.E.A.).

The three (03) winners will be officially announced during the meeting of the BSEC Working Group on Education, on **14 November 2019**, in **Istanbul** and the prizes will be awarded by the Secretary General of BSEC. On the same occasion, the Working Group will explore how to best ensure visibility of the awarded drawings.

We invite all the BSEC Member States to duly inform their competent Ministries about the Competition and encourage them to positively respond to this initiative of the Hellenic Chairmanship, which aims at further promoting the spirit of cooperation between young students of the BSEC Member States as well as raising awareness of the important role of BSEC in the wider Black Sea region.
